



The Mapula Trust is a registered South African NPC and PBO with the objectives of preserving the natural environment, environmental education, education itself, and animal welfare. It supports organisations active in these fields in various different ways and sees its strategic advantage in being able to make speedy interventions in cases where organisational size and bureaucracy may delay other potential supporters.

One of the major objectives of the Trust is the purchase of land valuable for its biodiversity value and the partnering with organisations who can provide on the ground land management. To date the Trust has purchased, and manages, over 5 000ha of land directly, and has provided funding for the WWF to purchase various other conservation worthy parcels of land. It has also entered into stewardship agreements with CapeNature on two properties it owns.
